

### For Grades 6-8

Between the months of September and April, students will have the opportunity to participate in the 100 Club reading program.

Students who read 4 or more books will receive rewards according to the chart below. These should be books read during the 2015-2016 school year. Books that students have read before can only be counted if they read them again. A maximum of 4 books from the preceding summer will be accepted that were read BEYOND the requirements of summer reading.

Participating students will need to submit a form with a parent signature for each book they read. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to parents to notify them that the form has been received with their signature. As students finish books, stickers will be added to charts in the library to track how many books each student has read. As students reach each reward level, they will receive an invitation to come to the library to claim the reward.

The program will end on Monday, April 18, 2016.

### **NEW THIS YEAR: NO READING LISTS!!!**

Students will be able to count titles toward this program that are owned by our library, according to the following guidelines:

<u>6th Grade</u>: Books in our YOUNG ADULT or FICTION sections of 120 pages or more, plus biographies and non-fiction in an appropriate reading/interest level.

<u>7th/8th Grade</u>: Books in our YOUNG ADULT or YA78 (7th & 8th grade only) sections, plus biographies and non-fiction in an appropriate reading/interest level.

A list of recommended biographies and non-fiction books will be provided.

(The library staff reserves the right to deny credit for books that are clearly below a junior high interest level.)

An open house will be held in the library on Wednesday, May 4, for students who have read at least 20 books. They can come during lunch, study hall, or after school for desserts, snacks, and a gift bag.
